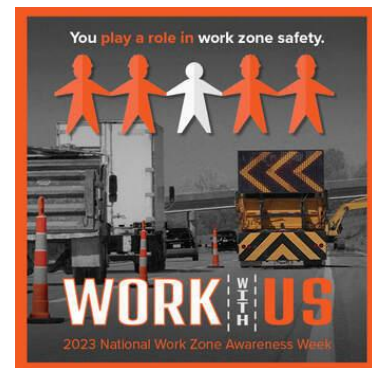
### Distracted Driving Awareness Month
